Several formats are available. Text is printed on the back side of “Prayer Cards” or on the interior of “Memorial Folders. A small “Black & White” photo may be included on the back of “Prayer Cards” with room left for a *very brief* phrase (adjusted & limited to 4 lines of approximately 130 characters at font size 9) or custom verse; also a photo may be included on the interior of “Memorial Folders” *...
